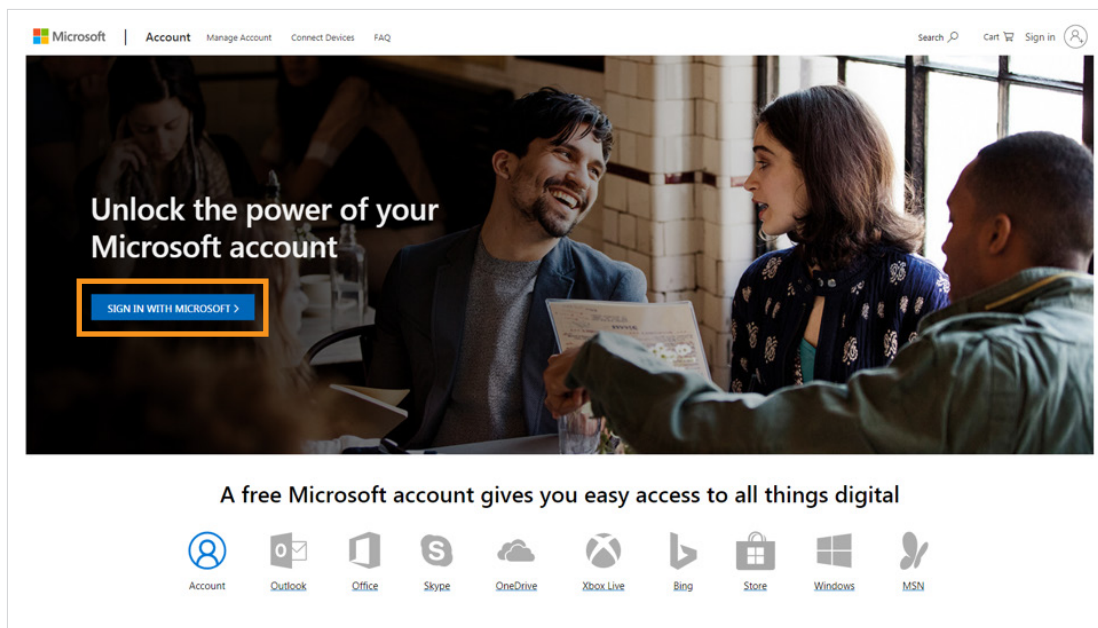


**NOTE: Setting up your email accounts on your Sat-Fi2 app must be done while using LTE or Wi-Fi connection.**

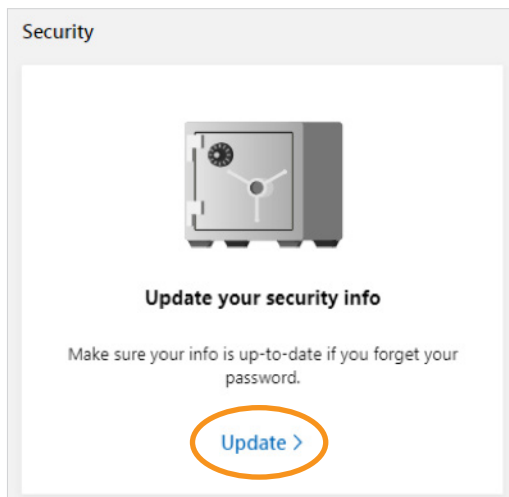
The Sat-Fi2 app will request to enable Two-step verification and create an App Password for Outlook, Hotmail and Office 365 accounts.

Follow the instructions to complete these steps:

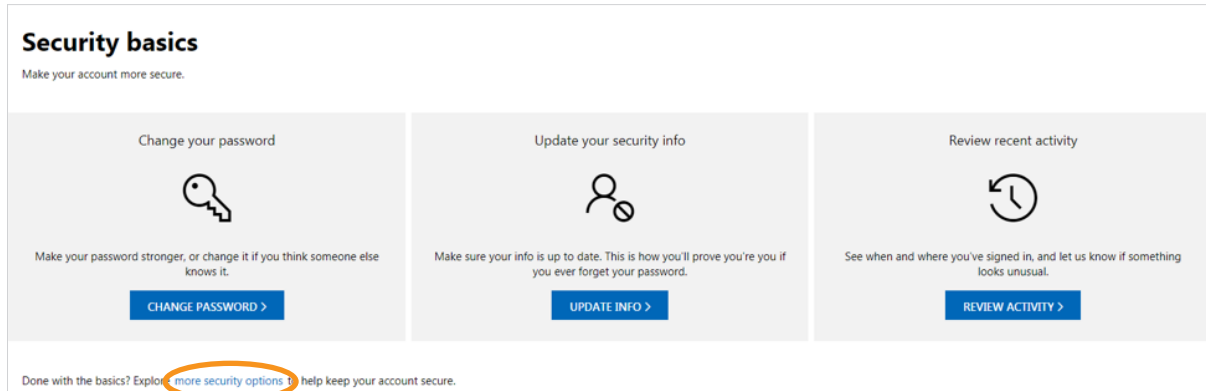
1. To turn on two-factor authentication, go to [Security basics](#) page, select sign in and enter your login information.



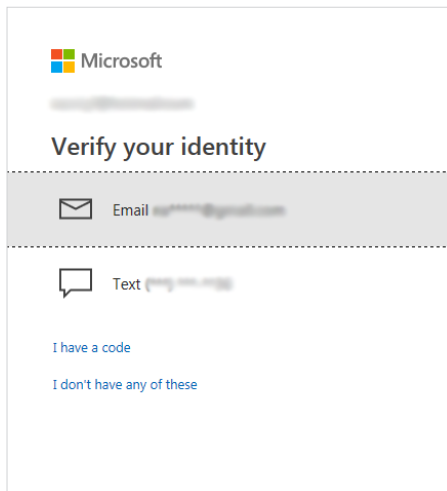
2. Once logged in, select **Update** under the Security section.



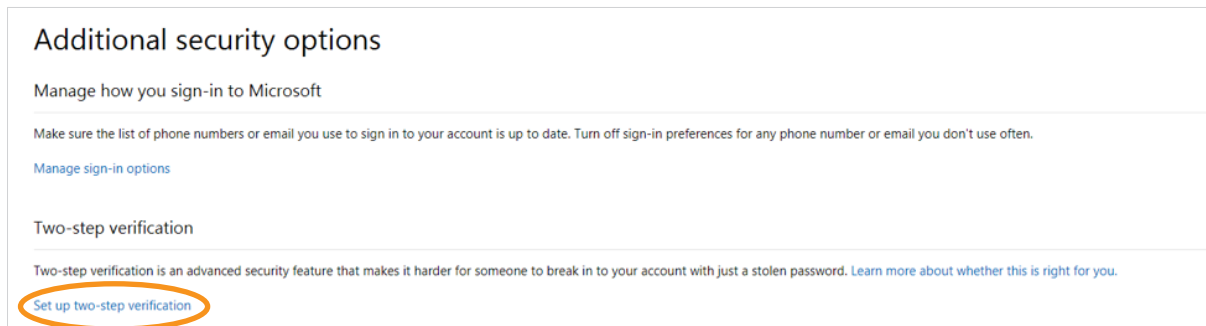
3. Select **More Security Options** at the bottom of the Security Basics page.



4. Then, Microsoft will ask you to verify your identity by sending a code via text or email.

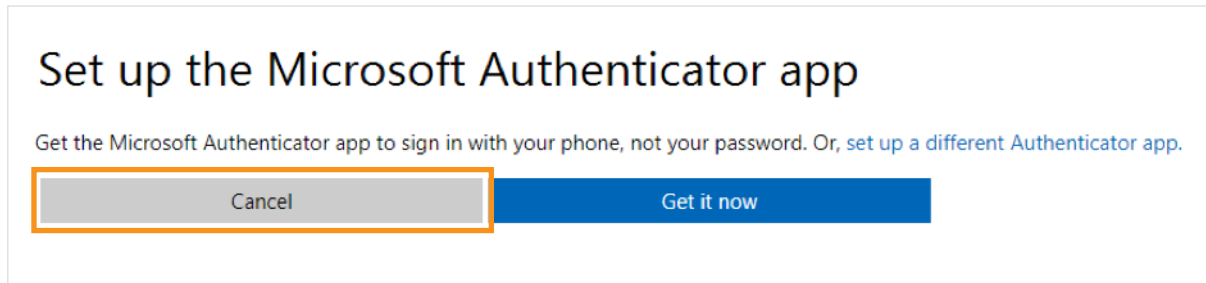


5. After the code is entered, select **Set up two-step verification** under the Additional Security Options page.



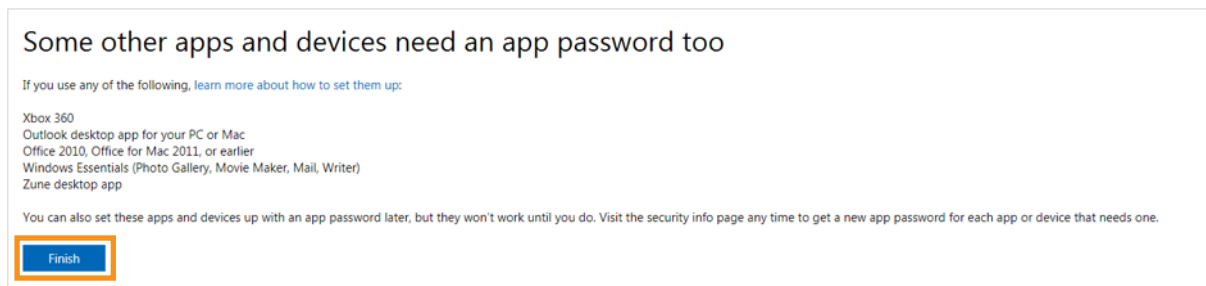
6. The Set up two-step verification page will explain the importance of the enabling this feature. Select **Next** to continue.

7. Select **Cancel** under Set up the Microsoft Authenticator app to get to the next page.



The Two-step verification will be enabled.

8. You will then see a disclaimer about the app password. Select **Finish**.



9. Then, you will be directed to the Additional security options page, select **Create a new app password** under the App passwords section.



10. The system will then generate an app password.
