

NOTE: Setting up your email accounts on your Sat-Fi2 app must be done while using LTE or Wi-Fi connection.

The Sat-Fi2 app will request to enable Two-step verification and create an App Password for iCloud.

First verify your email is enabled in your iCloud account. If your account does not have iCloud, follow the instructions on this link: https://support.apple.com/kb/ph2620?locale=en_US

Follow the instructions below to enable Two-step verification and create an App Password:

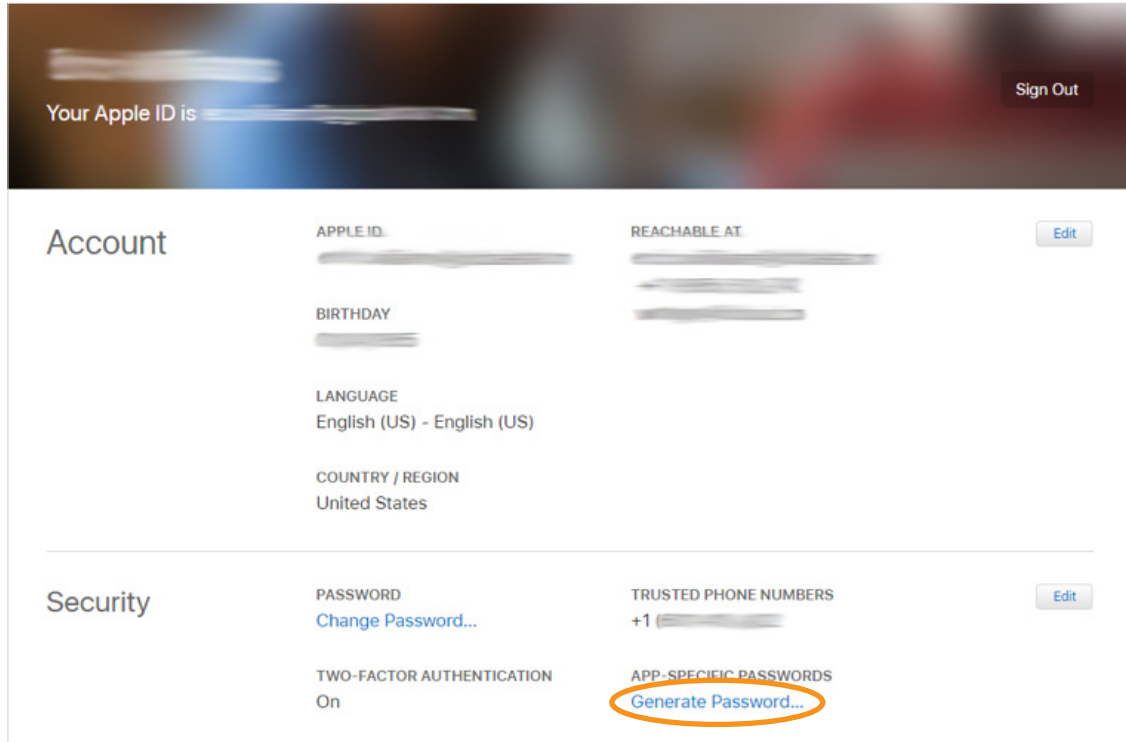
Two-Factor Authentication Setup:

1. To turn on two-factor authentication from your iPhone, go to **Settings**.
2. Tap on **your name**.
3. Tap on **Password & Security**.
4. Tap on **Two-Factor Authentication**.
5. Tap **Continue**.
6. Enter a phone number which will be used to authenticate your identity. You can choose to receive a text message or a call.
7. Tap on **Next**. You will then receive the verification code to the phone number provided.
8. Enter the verification code to authenticate the phone number and turn on two-factor authentication.

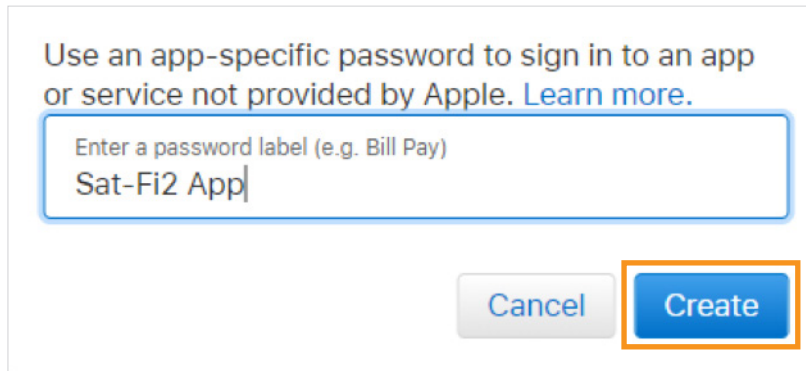
NOTE: Once the "Two Factor Authentication" has been enabled, an app specific password must be created.

App-Specific Passwords Setup:

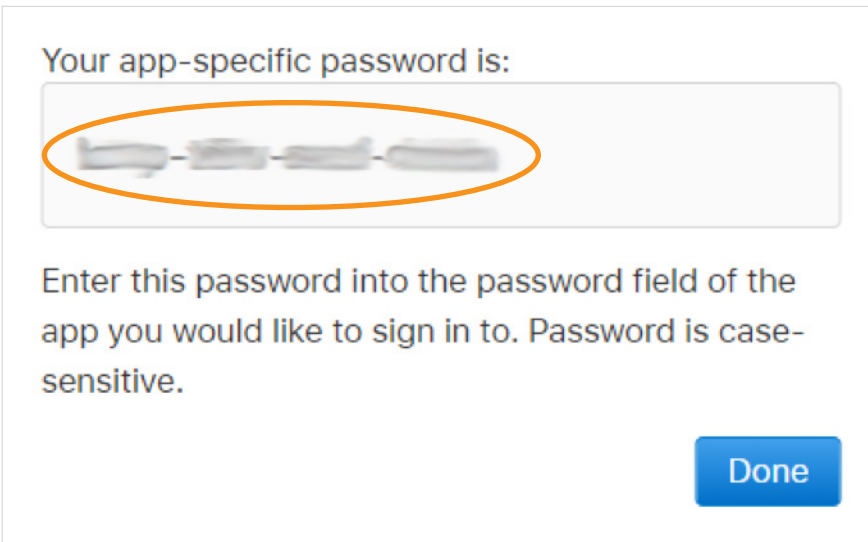
1. Sign in to your [Apple ID account page](#).
2. Under the Security section, select **Generate Password**.



3. A pop up will be displayed asking to enter the app's name. In this case, you will enter Sat-Fi2 App, then click on **Create**.



- The app-specific password will be generated.



- Select **Done**.
